

Covid-19 Relocation Guidelines



Your move can still happen during the Coronavirus Pandemic

What you should know

Moving companies fall under shipping, transportation and logistics categories, and as such, are considered essential business in most states. Our moving contractors are adopting a range of precautions to ensure the safety of employees and homeowners during a relocation. Although movers are considered low-risk for the transmission of Coronavirus, essential steps have been implemented by HSR's carriers to minimize the threat of exposure.

What movers are doing:

- On-site surveys for the calculation of household goods inventory and weight are being replaced with virtual video surveys
- Increased cleaning and sanitation of moving trucks, equipment, offices and warehouse facilities
- Pre-move health checks for both team members and customers.
- Social distancing protocols are maintained with a 6-foot distance rule as well as avoiding any physical touching or handshakes.
- Movers use gloves and booties and are armed with hand washing and sanitation supplies.

What you can do:

- Designate a hand-washing station for movers. Provide plenty of soap, disinfectant wipes and disposable paper towels.
- Avoid pre-used packing supplies. Only use new packing containers or what is already available in your home.
- Keep belongings sanitized and free from contagions with sealed bags and containers.
- Wear gloves when packing and unpacking and wash hands frequently
- increase ventilation by opening doors and windows when moving in or out of your home
